Job Duties:

Felling pre-selected ash trees on roadway rights-of-way, public lands and private property; carefully peeling bark from trunks and large branches by hand to locate beetle larvae; collecting samples, documenting findings, and properly disposing of wood and brush. Completing all paperwork accurately and correctly and in a timely manner.

Knowledge and Skills Required:

Safety is a paramount concern for this position. The ideal candidate should be organized, detail-oriented, possess map-reading skills, knowledge in care and use of chain saws and have legible handwriting. Familiarity with GPS units and computers are a plus. Must be comfortable working in groups of two under limited supervision. The job will require all-weather, all-terrain work using hand saws, chain saws and draw knives. Some brush chipper work may be required. Traffic control and roadside work are also required. Overnight travel, up to three nights a week will be required.

Qualifications Required:

Residents of Wisconsin only and at least 18 years of age. Must have a valid Wisconsin driver's license and a Social Security card (not just the Social Security number).

Salary and Work Schedule:
